- The NFDC was formed in 1941 in to a request from the Government to bring the industry together.
- Today, the Federation has 160 Corporate members and 65 Associate members
- These are split into five regions

Together, the NFDC's members are responsible for almost 90 percent of the demolition that takes place in the United Kingdom With members carrying out significant projects in mainland Europe

- The NFDC is at the forefront of revising and updating technical specifications for the industry










- The NFDC has produced model conditions of contracts and sub-contracts

Accredited Site Audit Scheme



- The scheme is designed to benchmark and monitor member companies performance and has been partnered with CHAS to demonstrate that the Federations high standards are independently audited.
- The audit includes a thorough inspection of the company health & safety policy followed up with a site inspection to ensure described procedures are being implemented on site.

- The Accredited Site Audit Scheme was designed as a quality mark for NFDC members.

- It sets us aside from non-member companies
- It provides our customers with an assurance of quality.

Training continued




- A condition of membership requires members to train all of their demolition operatives, through from operative level to manager level. On admittance to membership of the federation, each new member automatically becomes a member of the NDTG and are required, as a condition of continuing membership, to participate in courses provided by the training group.
- The NFDC Site Audit Schemes enforces the requirement for training by NFDC Members.
